

# SCOPE

The ESTEP Annual Event 2025 aims at bringing together the European steel community to explore research and innovation in decarbonization, digitization, and circular solutions that will shape the sustainable future of the European steel industry.

Achievements, challenges, and future perspectives will be examined through contributions from diverse European steelmaking stakeholders and presentations of ongoing projects under the Clean Steel Partnership. The event will foster dialogue between the steel sector and other key industries engaged in the European Green Deal—such as for e.g. cement, water, and aluminium—to promote industrial symbiosis and cross-sector collaboration.

The event will take place at the Università degli Studi di Udine – Biblioteca Rizzi. The event also includes a visit of ABS and DANIELI Automation facilities on 28 October 2025.

Remark: This year's edition will feature both oral presentations and a dedicated poster area. If your abstract is not selected for a presentation, it may still be showcased during the poster session.
