Ms. Schad-Dankwart studied economics at the University of Heidelberg and the University of Cologne. In addition to her work at IW Köln Consult, Ms. Schad-Dankwart completed her PhD in the field of economic and social psychology at the University of Cologne on the topic of "Rational regulatory policy for irrational people" from 2010-2013.

Since 2016, Ms. Schad-Dankwart is a senior researcher at the Federal Institute for Vocational Education and Training, where she is responsible for various industrial-technical professions in the area of regulatory work. In addition, Ms. Schad-Dankwart is involved in various research projects on topics such as "Women opt for STEM", "Attractiveness of Career paths" or "Vocational Education 4.0". In this context, she is intensively dealing with the question regarding the influence of different trends such as digitalization, greening or migration on dual education and the need for new competences and qualifications. In addition, she is currently entrusted with the development of an indicator system as a scientific base for an early detection system and systematic monitoring of occupations – especially focused on regulatory work.
